## I am Spartacus



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Are we all to become slaves to the fiat debt empire? As the cost of living rises and evermore get dragged down to the lower common denominator there will be sufficient numbers of educated and informed people to drive for change. We can disrupt payment systems. We can save with physical gold, silver or digital currency like Bitcoin. We could avoid banks and use credit unions, crowd funding and other community options including barter.
